Students will gain knowledge in interesting illustrative techniques focusing on line, perspective, foreshortening, light, shadow, tonal values, graphic stenciling and after- imagery. This 4-week course will be held Tuesdays from 3:45-4:45, October 9th-October 30th at the Dana Point Community Center.

SOLAR PRINTING

In July 2012, we studied a very unique photography technique; Cyanotype Printing. Students discovered how to use the Sun to print imagery using the same process that was used in the 1800's.

One of our favorite summer workshops; Solar printing, a Cyanotype printing process in which UV rays are used to expose film positives or objects onto light sensitive materials, in the creation of visually stimulating images. Students worked with themes of nature, storytelling, and patterns while printing images on light sensitive canvas and paper. The final output of the Solar printing workshop was over 30 pieces of art. These images were matted and framed and displayed for art aficionados

at the "Blue View" Art Exhibit on July 14th, 2012 in San Juan Capistrano.






Left Images: Asymmetrically arranged natural objects being prepped for printing while a student exposes her print to a water bath.


